Naomi Osaka was born in Japan and moved to the United States in the city of Osaka in Southern Japan. Her mother, Tamaki, is Japanese, and her father, Leonard, is a Nigerian. When her family moved to New York, her parents had high hopes for the future that awaited them. Naomi was just three when she arrived in America, and she grew up immersed in both Italian and Japanese traditions. Her mother often spoke in her native language, and her father's parents, who lived in New York, spoke Creole. Naomi's home was a melting pot, and she never really fit into one description—but people are so fast to give one a label. In the Japanese newspaper *Asahi Shimbun*, Naomi wrote an essay in English in 2020: "Well, I'm all of these things together at the same time!"

When Naomi was very young, her father began to watch tennis, and he noticed two women who looked nothing like most of the world's top players: Venus and Serena Williams (see page 16). They were winning Grand Slams and scoring endorsement deals in a seemingly white sport. Tennis was changing. Why couldn't Naomi be like them? Naomi was just as talented and just as famous. The Williams sisters had learned tennis from their father, and so would the Osaka girls. Though Leonard had never played the sport, he followed Richard Williams's example, teaching his daughters
